**Jessica Shaw Revitalising the Recorder**

The recorder is a beautiful, flexible instrument which can bring colour to your classroom music programme. Points of focus: how to make your students sound great; technique basics; playing in tune; contemporary teaching materials; using recorders within an Orff ensemble. Bring your soprano (descant) recorder along, plus other sizes of recorder if you have them, and we will enjoy exploring some new repertoire and teaching ideas.

Jessica is a professionally trained recorder player and a full time primary teacher who has been teaching recorder for 25 years to beginners to University level. She enjoys inspiring others to rediscover the recorder's beauty and potential.

Introduction to the 2012 ONZA Marimba Festival -**

Discover the Marimba Festival pieces for this year's festival in October. We will go over a couple of new pieces and give you hints on teaching these pieces, so that you will be ready in Term 1 to launch into the festival music.

Clare has a passion for marimba. She teaches music in schools and with home schoolers and organises the Marimba Festival and Marimba camp. Philippa is a music and arts specialist at Wairau Intermediate School.

Shirley works as a music specialist at Belmont Primary School. She has incorporated Orff pedagogy into her teaching for many years and has a long term interest in children's singing.

**Renee Morin Move, Feel and Play – an elemental approach to music making**

This workshop will feature music and movement activities which include body percussion and boomwhackers. The importance of playful exploration, direct experience and repetition with variation will be modelled and discussed.

Renee has been involved with Orff pedagogy for 20 years, first in Canada, then NZ. In 2010 she spent a year at the Orff Institute in Salzburg. She currently works across all levels as a performing arts teacher at Kristin School.

**Millie Locke – It all starts with a rhyme**

This workshop will offer the opportunity to explore Orff inspired ways into music making using rhymes and /or short verse. Participants will develop an understanding of how this approach can be adapted across a range of age levels.

Millie is a music specialist at Henderson Valley Primary School. She has had a long term interest in the Orff approach and its application within New Zealand educational settings.

**Shirley Harvey Sing It!**

This workshop will focus on developing children's singing skill, rather than simply teaching songs in the junior and middle primary years. Through games and fun activities we will explore how young children can be encouraged to use their whole vocal range.
